Purpose:

Class is designed to promote safer rides in the future, building upon fundamental horsemanship for riding in the real world. Class will cover handling skills from the ground to mounted and is intended for the serious student. You will be challenged in a safe manner; you will start to understand what control means.

Objective:

Too many times a ride goes from safe to sorry. You can never predict a situation but you will react to it. This training will focus on understanding what is needed to react appropriately to reduce the potential for an unsafe ride.

Control necessary to manage the course:

- Must be able to walk, trot and lope; stock will be asked to push forward with distractions; handler and stock will be asked to hold their ground with distractions

Course will introduce and improve on the following:

- Work a basic trail course with challenges
- Work on drill formations as a group
- Push a crowd
- Introduction to flares and fireworks
